Officer Reports:

Seneschal:

- Ropes and Storage Tubs Update:
 - We will wait until after Pennsic to get A&S Storage tubs.
 - Rope is on backorder.
- Ponte Alto asked for permission to reach out to sites in Stierbach.
 - Possibly acceptable with Stierbach's participation on a case-by-case basis.
 - A question: Who would get newcomers from a Ponte Alto event held in Stierbach?
 - Possibility: Partnership to co-event and co-welcome newcomers?
- Barony plans to hold an Aug. meeting over Pennsic.
- 2 new awards for group recognition.
- There will be an offset of Chancellors (Atlantia University) so that Chancellors have a month of training.
- Seneschal's Meeting
 - Emphasized the timely signing of financial documents and reports.
 - Event Stewards must be warranted as Deputy Seneschals.
 - SCA Insurance Price Changes:
 - Named Insurance: Now \$75.
 - Liquor Insurance: \$75.
 - Golf Carts: \$75.
 - Equestrian Insurance: \$200
 - All Officers need deputies (drop dead / backup).
- Grievances should be handled at the local level whenever possible. There is a Kingdom process.
- New Youth Officer for Kingdom – related to facilitating Children's fete.
