QuarterMaster: We will be loading up a trailer Thursday at 5:30 to grab stuff for Baronial Birthday. We would love your help if you can come out.


Exchequer: A separate report with financial details is attached at the end.

Having added Holland and Flanders to their dominion, the Dukes of Burgundy had access to the latest fabrics of Italy and the East and to English wool exports through the great trading cities of Bruges and Antwerp. Burgundian dress is a type of loose court outer gown with fitted sleeves which overlap the palms of a wearer.
